



## MRHP Sticky Notes

### Purpose

MRHP (most responsible health care provider) Sticky Notes are a “Comment” type clinical communication available to all inpatient clinicians. They are best used for simple updates and tasks brought to the attention of the attending physician team, much like a “doctor to-do clipboard” in paper workflows.

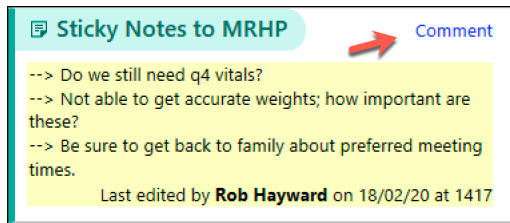
### Use Cases

- ✓ *Nursing team enters and updates MRHP Sticky Note content to signal non-urgent tasks, chart clean-up, or other operational needs that can be addressed the next time the responsible prescriber (team) presents for ward rounds that include the patient.*
- ✗ *Communications about changes in patient status, orders needed, or new interventions suggested should be communicated by phone, pager, or secure chat according to the communication pact agreed to by a particular clinical team.*

### User Experience

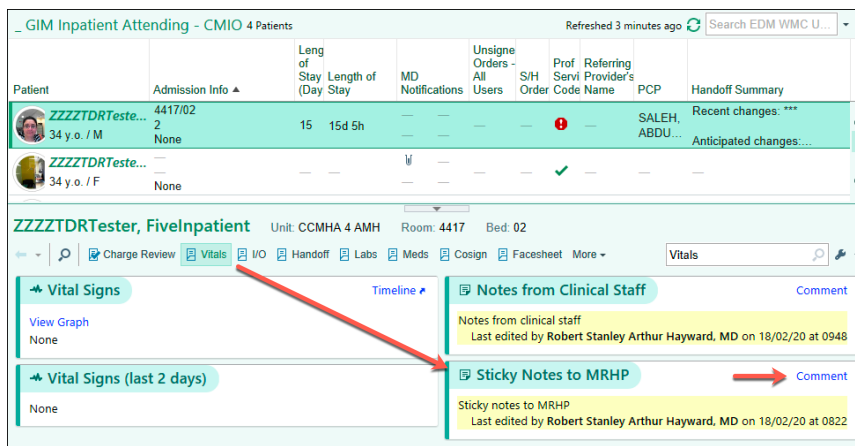
#### Inpatient Summary

- The Sticky Notes to MRHP section of the inpatient Summary Activity (Overview) allows SmartText-enabled editing of the current note.



#### Patient List Vitals Report

- The “Vitals Report” can be set to display when patient rows are selected in Patient Lists; containing by default the MRHP Notes.
- The Sticky Note can be edited directly from the Vitals Report by clicking on the “Comment” link.
