

## **Obstetrics (Pregnancy) Sticky Notes**

#### **Purpose**

"Pregnancy Sticky Notes" are a "Comment" type of clinical communication available to all prescribers for all patients in all contexts (e.g. outpatient, inpatient, Stork, etc.), used for simple annotations shared and co-edited by all providers about a patient's pregnancy.

#### **Use Cases**

- ✓ Quick points to help orient prescribers to the patient's pregnancy when the formal chart has many pregnancy-related and non-pregnancy related observations.
- ✓ Overall comment about how the pregnancy has been progressing or any unique psychosocial or family considerations that would not normally be documented in progress notes.
- ✓ Share one or more observations that might be important "heads-up" signals to other members
  of birthing team respecting patient, social or environmental factors that may affect the process
  and outcomes of pregnancy.
- Any information that should be documented as a formal part of the medical record, where tools like patient care coordination notes and Stork notes are also shared and span all encounters.


#### **User Experience**
