

### **Specialty Sticky Notes (Specialty Comments)**

#### **Purpose**

"Specialty Sticky Notes" (Specialty Comments) are a "Comment" type of clinical communication available to all prescribers for all patients in all contexts (e.g. outpatient, inpatient, etc.). They are used to share simple chart annotations for prescribers in the same clinical area (specialty), with properties listed below.

#### **Use Cases**

- ✓ Share one or more observations that might be important "heads-up" signals to other members of a specialty team respecting patient, social or environmental factors that may affect the process and outcomes of specialty care.
- \* Any information that should be documented as a formal part of the medical record, where tools like patient care coordination notes are also shared and span all encounters.

#### **User Experience**

#### Storyboard

A Specialty Sticky Note icon appears at the top of the patient storyboard as a blue icon.





- A Specialty Sticky Note that already contains a comment is indicated by an icon with lines.
- Hovering over the icon reveals content. Selecting the icon opens the Note for editing.
- Selecting the "Show All" icon within the note will reveal a list of all non-null Specialty Sticky Notes.



#### **Snapshot**

 The Specialty Comments section of the patient Snapshot (Chart Review) allows SmartText editing of the current specialty note and a pop-up view of all non-null Specialty Sticky Notes.


A Specialty Sticky Note icon column can be added to customized appointment lists.
