

# **SmartTexts for Virtual Care**

## **Purpose**

Clinicians may wish to quickly document how patients have been informed about, and consent to proceed with, virtual care interactions. This crib-sheet offers examples that can be saved in personal SmartPhrases.

### **Use Cases**

- ✓ Pandemic public health directives may necessitate social distancing, including minimizing patient visits to medical offices, clinics or facilities. Healthcare providers may elect to offer virtual alternatives to in-person care.
- ✓ Patients may wish to minimize travel and request interaction with a clinician by means of telephone or teleconference.
- ✓ Virtual care assessments may be adequate, but not ideal, presenting both provider and patient with trade-offs associated with a health care intervention. Patients should be alerted to the benefits and risks of health interventions so that any consent to proceed is informed. Patients should also have the ability to decline a change in mode of health care interaction. It is prudent to formally document both information provided, and choices made.
