

Downtime Orderset Access

Connect Care ordersets are helpful when admitting or managing patients with complex presentations. However, the tools, like other write-functions, are unavailable during a PRD environment downtime. Printable versions of ordersets can be accessed on designated downtime computers stationed in clinics, inpatient units, emergency rooms and operating rooms.

Step-by-Step Orderset Downtime Access

- 1. Find the designated BCA (business continuity access) PC (workstation) in your clinical area.
- 2. Find the BCA Web icon (north or south as appropriate) and double-click to open.



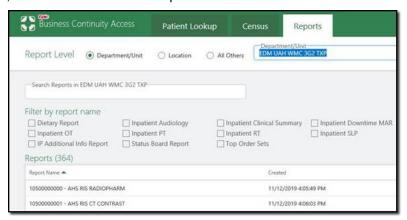

3. Use a valid Connect Care user ID and password to log in to the BCA application.



4. Once logged in, look for and select the "Reports" tab.



- 5. Select the appropriate inpatient unit or other clinical setting/department from the search box. Then browse, filter and/or search for an object of interest. This could be an orderset.
- 6. If, for example, a transplant orderset is needed, either scroll to its known Connect Care name in the list of reports or enter "transplant" as a search term and search. Click on the discovered orderset of interest and review the information that appears to the right to confirm that the right

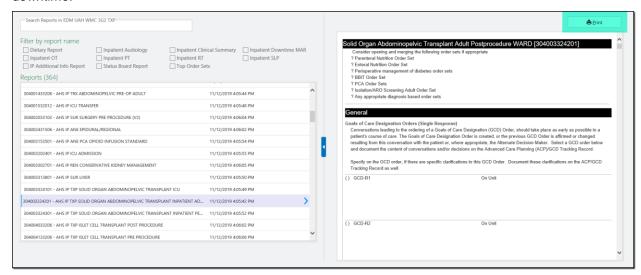
