



Finding eLearning Courses

MyLearningLink for Connect Care

“MyLearningLink” (MLL) is Alberta Health Services’ (AHS) online learning management system. It is used to facilitate the registration, scheduling, delivery, completion tracking and assessments (End User Proficiency Assessments, or EUPAs) for Connect Care training. Users can find information about their basic training courses and the dates, times and locations offered.

eLearning Courses & Demonstrations

MLL is used to access pre and post Instructor Led Training (ILT) courses, eLearning and demonstration videos. Each eLearning or demonstration is available in MLL as a unique course. Follow these instructions to search for, register, and then complete each recommended eLearning. Suggested or required eLearning(s) will have been identified in invitation email(s), basic training guides, personalization workshops, or optimization guides.

Accessing MyLearningLink

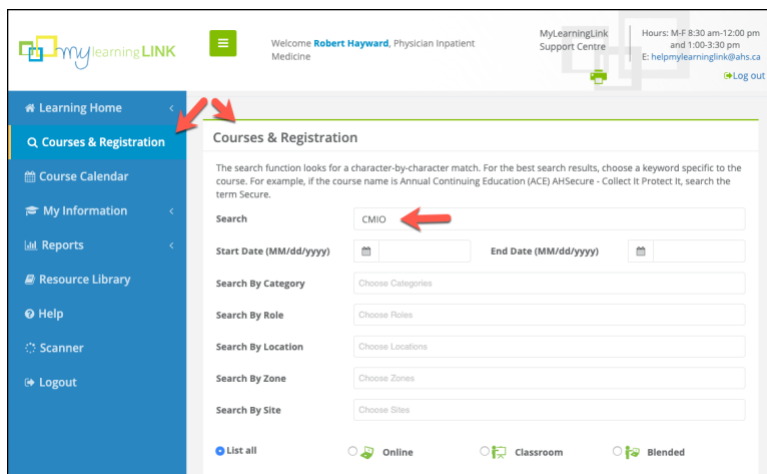
Use Internet Explorer or Edge on AHS computers, or Chrome on non-AHS computers to access MLL:

- mylearninglink.ahs.ca

When prompted, provide your usual AHS userid and password, then land on the Learning Home in MLL.

Searching for eLearning Courses

1. With MLL opened, select the “Courses and Registration” link in the MLL left column.



2. In the Search field, enter the course identifier for the eLearning of interest. This will have been provided in an email or in materials associated with Basic, Personalization or Optimization training. If uncertain, it is possible to enter “Epic - ” to list all Connect Care courses, or one of the following for specific groups of courses:



- “Epic - MD” to list most prescriber courses,
- “Epic - AMB” to list multidisciplinary courses related to ambulatory care,
- “Epic - ANE” to list anesthesiology courses,
- “Epic - CAR” to list cardiology courses,
- “Epic - ED” to list emergency medicine courses,
- “Epic - HKU” to list mobility courses,
- “Epic - KAL” to list ophthalmology courses,
- “Epic - MY” to list patient portal courses,
- “Epic - OB” to list obstetrics courses,
- “Epic - ONC” to list oncology courses,
- “Epic - OR” to list OpTime surgery courses,
- “Epic - RAD” to list radiology courses,
- “Epic - TXP” to list transplantation courses.
