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Measuring Recovery in Recovery Alberta



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Measurement-based care (MBC) is an evidence-based practice that improves client outcomes and underpins a learning health system. Implementation of MBC in Connect Care, using the CORE Outcome Measures, provided essential learnings on achieving successful spread and scale across Recovery Alberta. A key factor for sustainable implementation is the availability of brief measures of mental health and addiction recovery. This need was addressed by the CORE Recovery Outcome Measure (CORE-ROM) and the Monitor for Substance and Behavioural Addiction (MSBA).

This presentation will discuss research evidence supporting these new tools and offer recommendations for provincial spread and scale of digital MBC in Recovery Alberta.
